## **Requirements and language**

The Summer School in *Healthier Societies and Healthy organizations: Cross-cultural Perspectives*

is addressed to psychology Ph.D. students, young researchers and young professionals with research experience in psychology.

A maximum of 30 participants will be admitted in the Summer School, which will start if a minimum of 10 participants will enrol. The language of the course is English. The best research presented will be invited to submit a paper to be considered in Special Issues of international journals and/or in international books.

## **Eligibility**

Participants will be considered on the basis of their curriculum vitae, qualifications and their personal statement and motivation. In addition, a good knowledge of the English language is required (B2 level), as well as a previous knowledge or experience in psychology.

## **How to apply**

Candidates are required to fill and submit the application form, together with a personal statement and their curriculum vitae. All applications will be examined by a scientific selected committee. Deadline for applications is February 28, 2020.

## **Fee**

Standard fees for regular people: 225 €

Emerging countries and students fees: 75 €

Fees are due by April 2, 2020.

Fees include the following: course lessons, all course materials comprising reading materials, lunches, some social activities (social dinner is not included), access to Novoli Campus, Building D6, University of Florence, as well as to online services and resources (Wi-Fi).
