Purtroppo, la guerra scoppiata nell'Est dell'Europa, ha creato situazioni drammatiche e di grande dolore e tutti partecipiamo alla tragedia delle colleghe ucraine e dei bambini delle scuole di Poltava che fanno parte di questo progetto e con i quali stiamo continuando a costruire una cultura di pace.

The Erasmus Project "Writing for Inclusion" aims to build places of understanding and dialogue, inside and outside the school. They are places for children and adults, where everyone takes Care of themselves and others, through welcoming actions and mutual solidarity. By writing "stories" the children have built bonds of real friendship with their peers in other European countries and even today the exchange of "stories" continues. Unfortunately, the war that broke out in Eastern Europe has created dramatic situations of great pain and we all participate in the tragedy of Ukrainian colleagues and school children in Poltava who are part of this project. With them and with many other people in Europe, we are continuing to build a culture of peace. Today the state of the art of the project will be presented and the European partners will speak. Special thanks to the colleagues from Ukraine who will bear their testimony.


